I also want to clarify an apparent misunderstanding from the last meeting. Some attendees (and some that did not attend) were under the impression that the last meeting would not be dealing with issues of importance to the upper SR-1A zone (above 11th and below 14th Avenues). As I see it, the sub-division process has everything to do with many of the problems presently being experienced on upper F and H streets. The sub-division process is presently a subject of interest throughout the city. In the end, any recommendations regarding the sub-division process will move forward as recommendations for the entire city, not recommendations just for FH or the upper SR1-A areas. To make this happen we will need everyone's input and assistance. I have intentionally listed this issue early in the agenda because it is an issue of importance to the entire group. I also felt that there were some important procedural issues that needed our attention but that I am hoping can be dealt with quickly.
